An electronic guitar tuner will help you to easily tune the strings of the guitar to the correct notes. The tuner will show a needle that will be placed in the middle when the string is in tune. Some tuners have a microphone to pick up the sound of the note while other clip-on guitar tuners attach to the guitar headstock and pick up the vibration of the string when it's plucked.

Strike the tuning fork against a hard surface and listen to the note. If you are tuning an acoustic guitar, place the stem of the fork right behind the bridge of your guitar. The guitar will amplify the tone of the fork. If it is an "A" tuning fork, tune your open 5th string to the note (You will be an octave lower than the struck note). If your tuning fork is in "E", tune either E string to it. Tune the rest of the guitar using the method above.
